CAVE DIVING IN MEXICO

Mexico's flooded caves are some of the most extravagantly decorated on the planet. With 26° C/77° F water, little flow and shallow depths, divers can spend hours in the caves each day without ever worrying about deco. However, the characteristics that make Mexico's caves enjoyable also make them difficult to dive. Buoyancy and control are paramount, as the tiniest misplacement of a fin tip can destroy eons-old formations or mark a pristine silt hill. Our priority is safety, conservation and fun, in that order. We start in easier, more forgiving caves, and slowly increase the difficulty level according to the diver's skill set. You never have to dive in a deep, tight, or hyper-decorated tunnels if you don't feel up to it. There's something for every cave diver here.
