OUR TRAINING PHILOSOPHY

Our first and foremost goal for our students is to create competent, safe, and knowledgeable divers who are truly capable of independently diving with a similarly-certified buddy, without the supervision or help of a guide. We are generally very successful, and our alumni regularly rent tanks and dive together. However, understand that to achieve this level of proficiency requires a huge amount of work, both on the part of the student and that of the instructor. Our courses are charged per a day of training, and students earn a certification when the instructor feels they have fulfilled TDI/SDI standards, Under the Jungle standards, and are capable of diving without a guide. The number of days listed for the courses below are bare minimums, assuming the student does everything right the first time. To achieve the schedule below, plan on 10-12 hour days. Consider scheduling additional days of training for a more relaxed course or reserving porter services for shorter days. Course prices do not include required TDI/SDI E-learning.
